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## SunLine Receives Outstanding Marks from the FTA

General Manager Lauren Skiver told the Board that these results demonstrate a very solid operation here at SunLine.

The Triennial Review occurs once every three years and is one of the FTA's management tools for examining grant management, programs and operational practices. The review concentrated on policies, procedures and practices employed by Agency staff. SunLine received one minor deficiency this year, but was much improved from the four deficiencies it received in 2010.

"The excellent review confirms SunLine Transit Agency is committed to operational excellence," states Lauren Skiver. The Agency continues to move forward with high standards and ethical practices instituted under the leadership of Lauren Skiver and the direction of the SunLine Board of Directors. My colleagues and I have worked tirelessly to make SunLine a top notch organization; this just confirms it."

The comprehensive review by federal officials looks at many operational areas including: Legal; Financial Management and Financial Capacity; Technical; Maintenance; Procurement; Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE); Planning/Program of Projects; Title VI; Public Comment on Fare and Service Changes; Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA); Safety and Security; Drug Free Workplace; Drug and Alcohol Program and Equal Employment Opportunities (EEO).
