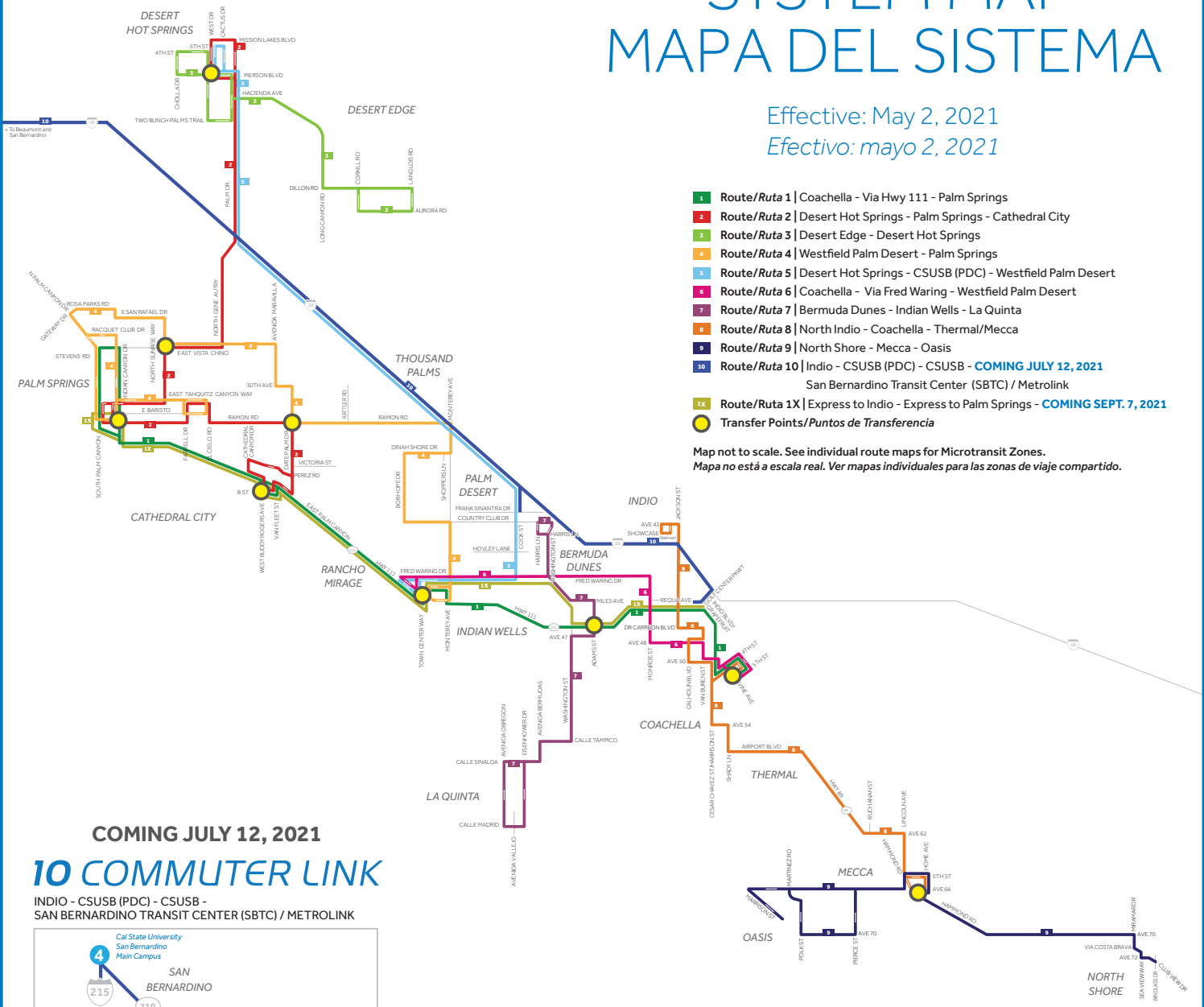

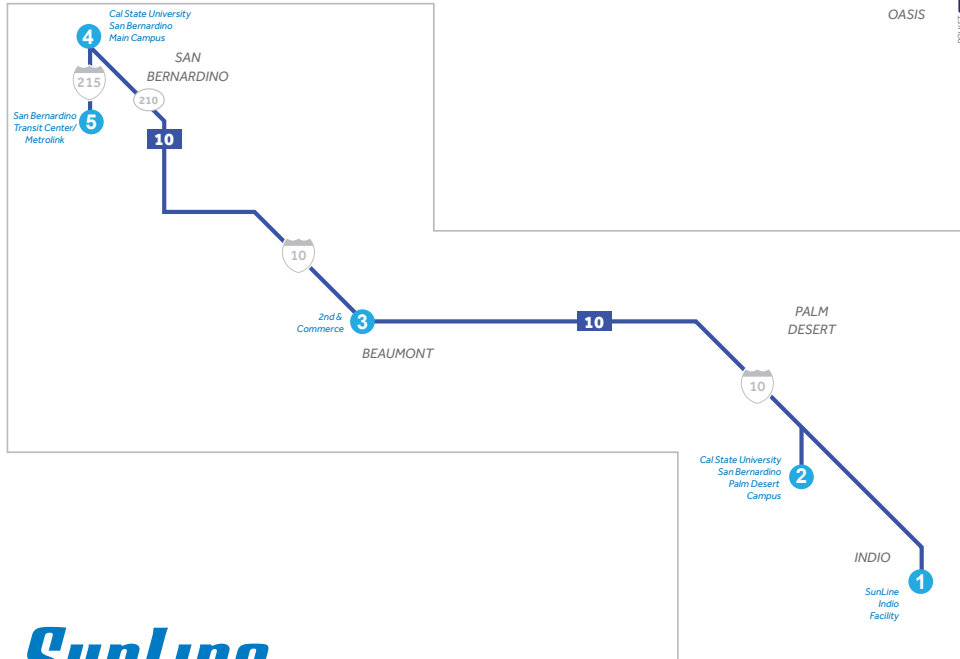

SUNLINE REFUELED

SunLine Refueled is here! While it was initially scheduled for three of the four SunLine Refueled pillars to launch on January 3, 2021 – due to continued COVID-19 concerns and the primary goal of keeping passengers and operators safe – we began implementation with a Consolidated Fixed Route and SunRide.

The SunLine Refueled plan lays out short- and long-term initiatives that support the local economy, meet the transportation needs of the Coachella Valley, and aid in recovery from the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. The four pillars bundled in SunLine Refueled will bring about greater transportation opportunities for our current and future customers. The four pillars of SunLine Refueled are:

A **Consolidated Fixed Route Network** that optimizes our resources; this means fewer transfers and a more comfortable and leisurely ride for customers.



The **10 Commuter Link** improves regional service between the Coachella Valley and Greater Southern California, allowing for travel to and from San Bernardino with enhanced options to connect to a number of key destinations in Southern California via transfers at a major transit hub. – Coming July 12, 2021

SUNLINE REFUELED

SunRide is a microtransit service available in four Coachella Valley zones connecting riders to the fixed route network.

Route 1X will provide rapid service with limited stops along one of the Coachella Valley's primary corridors, Highway 111. Route 1X will travel between Palm Springs

and Indio – reducing travel times for customers riding long distances throughout the SunLine system. – Coming September 7, 2021

HOW TO USE YOUR RIDER'S GUIDE

Once you have determined the route(s) you need in order to reach your destination, follow these simple steps to plan your trip using the Rider's Guide:

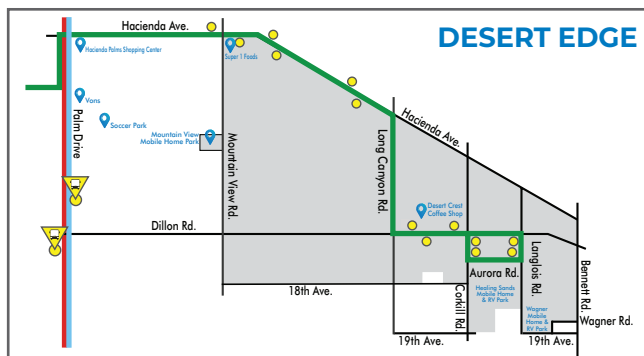
1. On the route map, locate the beginning and ending point of your bus trip and the direction that you will be traveling.
2. Locate the time point closest to your beginning and ending bus trip location. Time points are indicated on the route maps by a yellow circle and transfer points have a corresponding tag icon.

NOTE: Each time point on the route map has a corresponding column on the timetable. Not all bus stops are indicated on the map and there are many bus stops between each time point.

3. Find the column on the correct timetable that corresponds with your selected time point. Be sure you are using the timetable for the correct day of the week and direction of travel. Read down the column below the time point to find the time closest to your desired departure.

SUNRIDE

SunLine is dedicated to enhancing mobility options in the Coachella Valley. As part of SunLine's consolidated bus network redesign and the larger plan of SunLine Refueled, SunLine has identified communities that will benefit from on-demand door-to-bus stop service. This new microtransit service known as SunRide is available in Desert Edge, the Cook Street Corridor (Palm Desert), Coachella and Mecca-North Shore. Riders will use TransLoc®, a smartphone app, which calls for a SunRide vehicle to pick them up at a location within the designated zones and/or bus stops. The service is available throughout the week, Monday - Friday, 5:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.



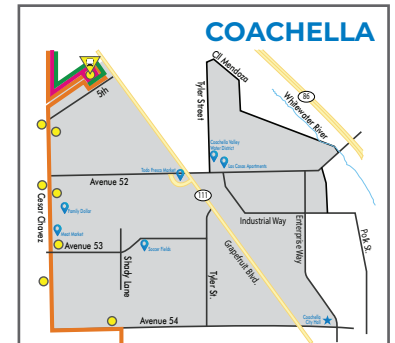
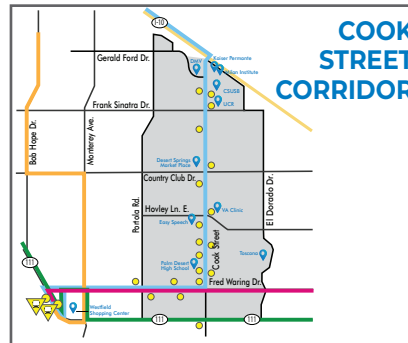
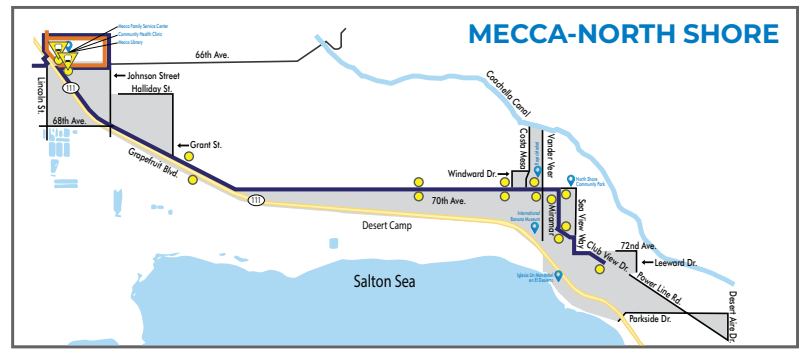
SUNRIDE

The cost is \$2.00 per person until July 2, 2021 (which excludes a transfer to the Agency's fixed route system). Beginning July 5, 2021, fares will be \$3.00 per person which will include a free transfer to the fixed route service.

SunRide's on-demand services allow you to book a trip within 15 minutes or to schedule a trip up to seven days in advance of your trip. ADA accessible vehicles available upon request.

RIDE WITH CONFIDENCE

To our valued riders, SunLine Transit Agency continues to take preventative steps in response to the potential spread of COVID-19.

FACE COVERING REQUIRED

The Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued an order on January 29, 2021, requiring the wearing of masks by travelers. SunLine continues to enforce face covering requirements for the safety of our riders, employees, and local communities. A face covering can be a bandana, scarf, neck gaiter or other clothing that does not have visible holes. This extends to our customers riding on board SunLine buses (fixed route and paratransit) and SunRide taxis. SunLine will require all riders to wear a face covering in a correct manner, no exceptions, until otherwise mandated by federal regulations.

BUSES AND PARATRANSIT VEHICLES

Each vehicle receives daily cleanings which include

disinfecting high touch surfaces (stanchions, handholds, and fareboxes).

The entire bus is fogged with disinfectant with the HVAC operating, in accordance with the manufacturer's recommended dilution ratio.

BUS STOPS

After pressure washing, the entire bus stop shelter, including pavement, it is sprayed with disinfectant using a hand pump sprayer.

CONTACTLESS PAYMENT

Pay your bus fare using your smartphone with the Token Transit app.

HAND SANITIZER

The installation of hand sanitizers is one of many steps SunLine is taking to ensure the health and safety of our riders. In a recent survey, SunLine riders identified

cleanliness on buses as one of the most important improvements.

AMERICAN PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION ASSOCIATION (APTA)

SunLine has earned the Health and Safety Commitment seal from APTA. This means we are fulfilling the highest industry commitments for keeping transit safe during COVID-19 by wearing masks, cleaning and disinfecting our vehicles and screening our employees. We ask you to help out by wearing a mask and maintaining social distance while riding the bus. To learn more, visit SunLine.org/Clean.

SAFETY TIPS FOR RIDERS

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Cough and sneeze into your elbow, not your hand. Alternatively, cough or sneeze into a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash and wash your hands.
- Clean and disinfect high-touch objects and surfaces.
- Riders should practice at least 6 feet social distancing. Social distancing is deliberately increasing the physical space between people to avoid spreading illnesses.

COMMITMENT TO CLEAN AIR

SunLine has positioned itself as a pioneer of zero-emission bus deployments, particularly for hydrogen fuel cell electric buses (FCEB). Fuel cell technology, which has been launched all over the world, was originally developed, tested, and brought to commercialization by SunLine Transit Agency. In 1993, SunLine's Board adopted a voluntary policy of pursuing alternative fuel solutions that provide the lowest possible emissions, which led SunLine to become the first transit agency in the state to convert its entire fleet to compressed natural gas (CNG). The current fleet includes 16 FCEBs and four battery electric buses, which comprise 24% of the fixed route fleet.

Did you know passenger cars produce the majority of the 5.8 billion metric tons of CO₂ dumped into the atmosphere each year? Riding a SunLine bus as an alternative to driving a vehicle in the Coachella Valley reduces over a

thousand miles driven per household annually. It's clear that the need for environmentally clean public transit is crucial to our future.

SunLine's environmental impact:

21,323,851 fewer car miles per year
895,960 gallons gas saved per year
7,947,165 kg CO₂ saved per year



SunLine is committed to transitioning its entire bus fleet to zero-emission in accordance with the Innovative Clean Transit Regulation by 2035, five years ahead of the deadline set by the California Air Resources Board. SunLine's innovative step positions it as a forerunner, leading the way to zero-emission solutions. SunLine's longstanding focus on the environment, with its clean fuels fleet, helps SunLine do its part to ensure natural resources are preserved for future generations.

FARES & PASSES

Please be aware that all passes are subject to all rules and regulations of SunLine Transit Agency. All sales are final, and no refunds will be issued. Passes are non-transferable. Any misuse may cause the pass to be void or revoked. The bus operator does not carry change and refunds will not be issued. Please pay exact fare.

- Maximum of 2 children (4 years and younger) ride free with a paid fare
- Youth 5 to 17 years must be prepared to show proof of age each time they board the bus
- Be prepared to show proof of age or disability with one of the following each time you board the bus: Medicare card, DMV ID card, SunDial Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Certification card, or SunLine Half-Fare ID card
- Passes can only be purchased through the Token Transit app or pass outlet locations (see page 26)

- Transfers are valid for two hours of unlimited rides from the time of purchase (see fare table on page 13)

TRANSFERS BETWEEN SUNLINE 10 COMMUTER LINK AND OMNITRANS



- Passengers with a valid SunLine 10 Commuter Link 1-Day or 30-Day pass transfer for free to any Omnitrans bus route at the San Bernardino Transit Center (SBTC) and at California State University San Bernardino (CSUSB).
- Passengers with a valid Omnitrans 1-Day, 7-Day or 31-Day pass transfer for free to SunLine 10 Commuter Link at the SBTC and at CSUSB.
- Omnitrans does not issue or accept transfer passes. SunLine passengers who need to change Omnitrans buses or who travel past the end of the line on an Omnitrans route must pay again unless they already have an Omnitrans pass.

- Transfers are not included in the single ride fare or 10-ride pass. For \$0.25, unlimited transfers up to two hours from time of purchase maybe added to a single ride fare or 10-ride pass.

TRANSFERS BETWEEN 10 COMMUTER LINK AND SUNBUS



- 10 Commuter Link 1-Day and 30-Day passes (see fare table on page 13) are good for unlimited travel on both SunBus and Commuter Link buses. A transfer fee is not required
- Passengers with a single ride pass transferring between SunBus routes or transferring from 10 Commuter Link to SunBus are required to pay \$0.25 for a SunLine Transfer pass

- SunLine or Omnitrans passengers who purchase a Commuter Link pass or an Omnitrans 1-Day, 7-Day or 31-Day pass on the Token Transit or Transit app should be prepared to show their digital pass when boarding Omnitrans buses.

TRANSFERS BETWEEN SUNLINE AND METROLINK



METROLINK

- You may use your one-way Metrolink ticket for one free ride on a SunLine bus departing the San Bernardino Metrolink station. You can also use your round trip Metrolink ticket or multi-day pass for one SunLine bus trip to and from a Metrolink station.
- Metrolink ticket/pass must be valid for date of travel. Expired passes not accepted.
- Show pass to driver when boarding. Valid on connecting routes only. Please note that Metrolink does not accept bus passes for discount train fare.

TRANSFERS BETWEEN SUNLINE AND RIVERSIDE TRANSIT



- Passengers with a valid SunLine 10 Commuter Link fare transfer for free to local RTA Route 31 at Beaumont.
- Passengers with a valid SunLine Commuter Link fare transfer to RTA Commuter Link Express 200 at the San Bernardino Transit Center (SBTC) by topping up their fare, regular fare transfer is \$1.75 and Senior/Disabled fare is \$2.00.
- Passengers with a valid RTA fare transfer to SunLine 10 Commuter Link by topping up their fare; regular fare transfer is \$5.00 and Senior/Disabled fare is \$3.50.
- RTA does not issue or accept transfer passes. SunLine passengers who need to change RTA buses or who

travel past the end of the line on an RTA route must pay again unless they already have an RTA pass.

- SunLine or RTA passengers who purchase a Commuter Link pass or any RTA pass on the Token Transit app should be prepared to show their digital pass when boarding RTA buses.

TRANSFERS BETWEEN SUNLINE AND OTHER TRANSIT AGENCIES

- SunLine bus passes are not accepted for free or discounted transfer on buses operated by Beaumont Transit, Banning Transit, Mountain Transit Authority or Victor Valley Transit Authority - BV Link.



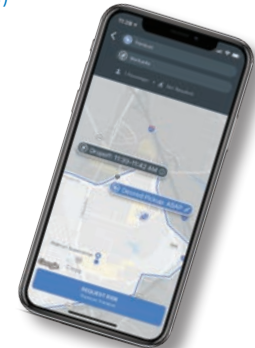

Si bien inicialmente estaba programado para el lanzamiento de tres de los cuatro pilares SunLine Refueled el 3 de enero de 2021, debido a las continuas preocupaciones de COVID-19 y al objetivo principal de mantener seguros a los pasajeros y operadores, comenzamos la implementación con una red de ruta fija consolidada y SunRide.

El plan SunLine Refueled establece iniciativas a corto y largo plazo que apoyan la economía local, satisfacen las necesidades de transporte del Valle de Coachella y ayudan en la recuperación de los impactos de la pandemia COVID-19. Los cuatro pilares incluidos en SunLine Refueled brindarán mayores oportunidades de transporte para nuestros clientes actuales y futuros. Los cuatro pilares de SunLine Refueled son:

CÓMO USAR SU GUÍA PASAJERO

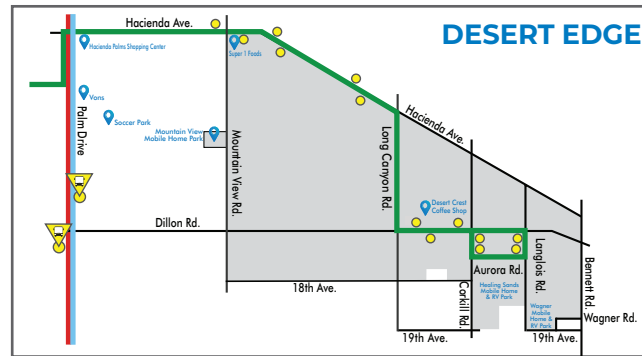
Una vez que haya determinado la(s) ruta(s) que necesita, siga estos simples pasos para planear su viaje usando la Guía del Pasajero:

1. En el mapa de rutas, localice el punto de partida y de llegada de su viaje en autobús y la dirección en la que lo hará estar viajando..
2. Localice el punto de tiempo con horario más cercano a su ubicación de partida y llegada de su viaje en autobús. Los puntos de tiempo se indican en los mapas de rutas con un círculo amarillo.

NOTA: Cada punto de horario en el mapa de ruta tiene una columna correspondiente en la tabla de horarios. No todas las paradas de autobús están indicadas en el mapa y hay varias paradas entre cada punto de tiempo.

3. En la tabla de horarios, encuentre la columna que corresponda con su punto de tiempo seleccionado. Asegúrese de usar la tabla de horarios que corresponda al día de la semana correcto y a la dirección de su viaje. 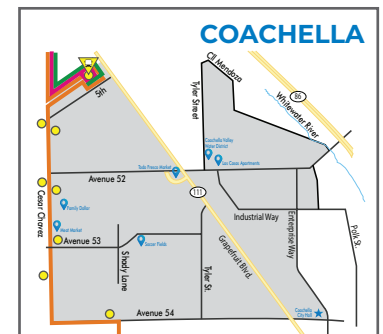
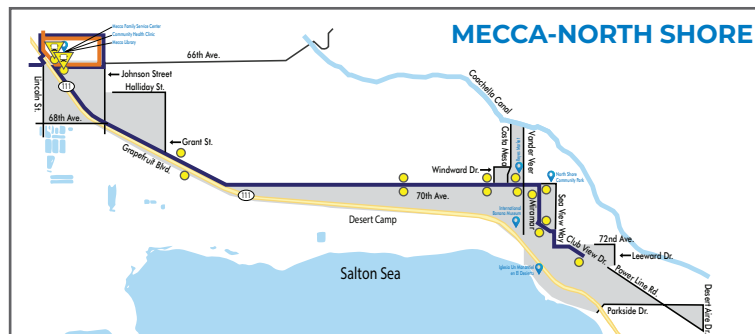
SunLine se dedica a mejorar las opciones de movilidad del Valle de Coachella. Como parte del rediseño de la red de autobús unificada de SunLine y el plan más general de SunLine Refueled, SunLine ha identificado comunidades que se beneficiarán los servicios de paradas a pedido de la puerta al autobús. Este nuevo servicio de microtransporte, conocido como SunRide, está disponible en Desert Edge, el corredor Cook Street (Palm Desert), Coachella y Mecca-North Shore. Los pasajeros usarán TransLoc®, una aplicación en sus teléfonos inteligentes mediante la cual solicitan un vehículo de SunRide para que los recoja en un localización dentro de las zonas designadas o en las paradas de autobuses. Este servicio estará disponible de lunes a viernes, de 5:30 a.m. a 6:30 p.m.



Como parte del costo es de \$2.00 por persona hasta el 2 de julio de 2021 (lo que excluye una transferencia al sistema de ruta fija de la Agencia). Comenzando 5 de julio de 2021, las tarifas serán de \$3.00 por persona, lo que incluirá un traslado gratuito al servicio de ruta fija.

Los servicios a pedido de SunRide le permiten reservar un viaje en 15 minutos o programar un viaje hasta siete días antes del viaje. Vehículos accesibles según la ADA disponibles a pedido.

Con nuestros valiosos pasajeros en mente, SunLine Transit Agency continúa tomando medidas preventivas para evitar la posible propagación de la COVID-19.

REQUISITO DE COBERTOR FACIAL

El Centro para el Control y la Prevención de Enfermedades (CDC) emitió una orden el 29 de enero de 2021, requiriendo el uso de máscaras por parte de los viajeros. SunLine continúa haciendo cumplir los requisitos de cubierta facial para la seguridad de nuestros pasajeros, empleados y comunidades locales. Una cubierta facial puede ser un pañuelo, bufanda, polaina para el cuello u otra ropa que no tenga agujeros visibles. Esto se extiende a nuestros clientes que viajan a bordo de los autobuses SunLine (ruta fija y paratransito) y los vehículos SunRide. SunLine requerirá que todos los pasajeros usen una cubierta facial de manera correcta, sin excepciones, hasta que las regulaciones federales exijan lo contrario.

ASOCIACIÓN ESTADOUNIDENSE DE TRANSPORTE PÚBLICO

SunLine ha obtenido el sello de compromiso con la salud y la seguridad de la Asociación Estadounidense de Transporte Público (APTA, por sus siglas en inglés). Esto significa que estamos cumpliendo con los compromisos industriales más importantes de mantener al transporte público seguro durante la pandemia de COVID-19 mediante el uso de máscaras, la limpieza y desinfección de los vehículos, y el testeo de los empleados. La instalación de desinfectantes de mano es una de las tantas medidas que SunLine está tomando para garantizar la salud y seguridad de los pasajeros. En una encuesta reciente, los pasajeros de SunLine identificaron la limpieza de los trenes

CONSEJOS PARA LOS PASAJEROS

- Lávese las manos con agua y jabón por 20 segundos, como mínimo. Si no tiene agua y jabón disponibles, use un desinfectante de manos a base de alcohol.
- Evite tocarse los ojos, la nariz y la boca si no se lavó las manos.
- Evite el contacto estrecho con personas enfermas. Tápese con el codo al toser y estornudar, no con la mano.
- También puede cubrirse con un pañuelo y luego tirarlo a la basura y lavarse las manos.
- Limpie y desinfecte los objetos y las superficies de gran contacto.
- Los pasajeros deben mantener la distancia social. Esto es mantenerse más alejado de las personas para evitar la propagación de la enfermedad.

SunLine ha posicionado como un pionero en el despliegue de autobuses de cero emisiones, en particular para los autobuses eléctricos de combustible de hidrógeno. La tecnología de pilas de combustible, que se ha lanzado en todo el mundo, fue desarrollada, probada y comercializada originalmente por SunLine Transit Agency. En 1993, la Junta de SunLine adoptó una política voluntaria de buscar soluciones de combustibles alternativos que proporcionen las emisiones más bajas posibles, lo que llevó a SunLine a convertirse en la primera agencia de tránsito del estado en convertir toda su flota a gas natural comprimido (GNC). La flota actual incluye 16 y cuatro autobuses eléctricos de batería, que comprenden el 24% de la flota de ruta fija.



¿Sabía que los automóviles de pasajeros producen la mayoría de las 5,8 mil millones de toneladas métricas de CO₂ que se vierten a la atmósfera cada año? Viajar en un autobús SunLine como alternativa a conducir un vehículo en el Valle de Coachella reduce más de mil millas conducidas por hogar

El enfoque de larga data de SunLine en el medio ambiente, con su flota de combustibles limpios, ayuda a SunLine a hacer su parte para garantizar que los recursos naturales se conserven para las generaciones futuras.

RIDING THE BUS

PLANNING YOUR TRIP

Use the schedules in this book to plan your trip, as well as the myStop® Mobile app. For more information on how to ride the SunBus, please visit SunLine.org.

WAITING FOR THE BUS

It's best to be at the bus stop five minutes before the bus is scheduled to arrive. Double check the bus schedule and map to be sure that the bus serves the stop and that it is traveling in the direction you want to go.

BOARDING THE BUS

Before getting on the bus, please let passengers get off and verify the route number by checking the sign on the front or side of the bus. To make boarding more accessible, every SunBus is equipped with lifts or ramps for passengers who have difficulty climbing stairs or use a personal mobility device.

PAYING YOUR FARE

For contactless payment, pay with your smartphone using the Token Transit app. Please have your exact fare ready before boarding the bus. Operators do not carry change. Transfers are purchased from the farebox when boarding the bus. A transfer is good for two hours of unlimited rides in any direction. For the passenger's convenience, a day pass can be purchased from the farebox. This pass allows unlimited rides for one full day.

TAKING A SEAT

The seats nearest the driver are designated for seniors or persons with disabilities. If you choose to sit in these seats and are not a senior or person with a disability, please be prepared to move if needed. For safety, always remain seated or hold on to the poles or straps when the bus is moving.

EXITING THE BUS

For your safety please remain seated until the bus comes to a complete stop. Pull the yellow cord above the window or push the vertical strip on the side of the window to signal the bus operator that you want to get off at the next bus stop.

DETOUR ROUTES

Detours are subject to change at any time. All detours and bus stop closure notices are available using the myStop® Mobile app or by visiting SunLine.org/Alerts.

SUNLINE PROGRAMS

BIKE & RIDE

Our riders gain greater flexibility and more options to get to their destination by combining two popular modes of transportation: the bicycle and the bus. Simply load your bicycle on an easy-to-use bike rack mounted securely to the front of every SunBus. Remember, you are responsible for loading, securing and unloading your bicycle from the bike rack. If your bike doesn't fit, do not try to force it. It may break or fall during travel.

COACHELLA VALLEY EMPLOYER PASS PROGRAM

The Coachella Valley Employer Pass incentive program allows businesses to provide their employees the ability to travel to and from work using the SunBus. The pass is valid for 31 consecutive days.

HALF-FARE PROGRAM

Based on the Federal Transit Administration's guidelines, this program is for riders who are 60+ years

of age or individuals with disabilities who are able to ride SunLine's fixed routes. To qualify for this program, applicants must show proof of age or disability. For more information, visit SunLine.org.

REASONABLE MODIFICATION

SunLine is committed to providing high-quality transportation services that are safe, efficient, and effective. SunLine is committed to making reasonable modifications to its policies, practices and procedures to avoid discrimination and ensure programs and services are accessible to individuals with disabilities. SOLVAN

Sharing a ride in a vanpool is a convenient, reliable and an economical way to get to work. SunLine offers a \$400 per month subsidy for qualified vanpools.

SUNFUELS

SunLine's commitment to clean air and alternative fuel options extends beyond our own fleet. SunFuels offers two alternative fuel stations in Thousand Palms and Indio. These 24-hour public CNG fueling stations accept VISA, MasterCard, Wright Express and Voyager for payment. Our CNG dispensers have a built-in card reader and dispense both 3000 psi and 3600 psi.

TAXI VOUCHER PROGRAM

SunLine's Taxi Voucher Program provides taxi services at a reduced rate to seniors and persons with disabilities who qualify under SunLine's guidelines. Funds are placed on a debit smart card which is accepted by two Coachella Valley taxicab businesses: Desert City Cab and Yellow Cab of the Desert. The program's goal is to complement the existing public transit system by creating flexibility of travel throughout the Coachella Valley via an on-demand service. The Taxi Voucher Program is currently funded through grants and is subject to change pending funding availability.

TRAVEL TRAINING PROGRAM

SunLine's Travel Training is a specialized program provided to seniors, persons with disabilities, or anyone interested in learning how to ride the local transit system. This program is provided at no cost. The program's goal is to help passengers travel independently, safely and confidently. Visit to calendly.com/Refueled to book a training.

SUNDIAL - PARATRANSIT SERVICE

SunDial is an origin-to-destination shared-ride transit service for people who are functionally unable to use the fixed-route service either permanently or under certain conditions. Eligibility is not solely based on having a disability. SunDial service is only available within $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile on either side of a SunBus local fixed route and may only be used at the same times, days and frequency as local fixed-route service. SunDial service is not provided for the area serviced by SunLine's 10 Commuter Link (service between Indio and San Bernardino).

The SunDial Operator will wait for you at the curb of a public street, in front of or as close as possible to your house, building, or other designated pick-up location that is safe. Door-to-door service is available for riders with disabilities requiring enhanced assistance and must be identified at the time of your reservation. Please watch for the vehicle, as the operator will wait no more than five minutes for you to come out for



your ride. SunDial Operators are not permitted to enter private driveways. Your ride will be shared with other passengers. Other pick-ups and drop-offs may occur during your trip, so please schedule accordingly. If passengers cannot take a scheduled trip, call SunDial reservations immediately and cancel your ride. Trips not canceled at least two hours before the scheduled pick-up time will be considered a late cancellation. Trips not canceled prior to the scheduled pick-up time and/or passenger's failure to be present will be considered a no-show. SunLine reserves the right to suspend service for any passenger.

WHO CAN RIDE SUNDIAL?

Those eligible to ride SunDial are people who have certain disabilities that prevent them from using the SunBus fixed-route transit system and possess a valid SunDial ADA Certification ID Card. These disabilities include:

- Physical
- Cognitive
- Emotional
- Visual

SunDial riders must complete SunLine's eligibility process and receive a SunDial ADA Certification ID Card. Visitors to the Coachella Valley may obtain a temporary 21-day pass by contacting SunLine in advance and providing proof of disability information or certification information pass from another transit agency.

FOR YOUR SAFETY

Federal and state laws require all SunDial clients to

use seatbelt and shoulder harness devices while being transported on all vehicles. The operator will ensure that all passengers are secured prior to transporting and will assist with securing and removing such devices. Please pay exact fare. The operator does not carry change and no refunds will be issued.

ESPERANDO EL BUS

Para que el abordaje sea más accesible, cada SunBus cuenta con elevadores o rampas para los pasajeros que tienen dificultades para subir escaleras o usan un dispositivo personal de movilidad.

PAGUE EL BOLETO

Además, puede pagar sin contacto mediante la aplicación Token Transit de su teléfono inteligente. Tenga el dinero exacto para pagar el boleto antes de subirse al autobús. Los conductores no llevan cambio. Debe comprar los trasbordos en la máquina canceladora cuando sube al autobús. Un trasbordo tiene una validez de dos horas para realizar viajes ilimitados en cualquier dirección. Para la conveniencia del pasajero, se puede comprar un pase de un día en la máquina canceladora. Este pase permite realizar viajes ilimitados durante todo un día.

SIÉNTESE

Los asientos más cerca del conductor están destinados a las personas mayores o discapacitadas. Si decide sentarse en estos asientos, pero no es una persona mayor ni discapacitada, debe moverse de ser necesario. Para su seguridad, permanezca sentado o sujetado de los postes o las correas cuando el autobús esté en movimiento.

BAJE DEL AUTOBÚS

Por su seguridad, permanezca sentado hasta que el autobús se detenga por completo. Tire del cordón amarillo que se encuentra sobre la ventana o tire de la correa vertical que se encuentra junto a la ventana para indicar al conductor del autobús que desea bajarse en la siguiente parada.

TRAYECTOS DE DESVÍO

Los desvíos están sujetos a cambios en cualquier momento. Puede consultar todos los desvíos y los avisos de cierre de paradas de autobús en myStop® Mobile app o visitando SunLine.org/alerts.

PROGRAMA DE PASES PARA EMPLEADORES DEL VALLE DE COACHELLA

Un programa de incentivo que permite que las empresas proporcionen a sus empleados la posibilidad de viajar hacia y desde el trabajo con SunBus. El pase tiene una validez de 31 días consecutivos.

PROGRAMA DE CUPONES PARA TAXI

Proporciona servicios de taxi a una tarifa reducida para las personas mayores y discapacitadas que califican en virtud de las pautas de SunLine. Se transfieren fondos a una tarjeta de débito inteligente que dos empresas de taxis del Valle de Coachella aceptan: Desert City Cab y Yellow Cab of the Desert. El objetivo del programa es complementar el sistema existente de transporte público al generar flexibilidad de viajes en el Valle de Coachella mediante un servicio a pedido. El Programa de cupones para taxi actualmente cuenta con la financiación de programas de subvenciones y está sujeto a cambios según la disponibilidad de la financiación.

SOLVAN

Compartir un viaje en camioneta es una manera conveniente, fiable y económica de llegar al trabajo. SunLine ofrece un subsidio de \$400 por mes para las camionetas calificadas. SUNFUELS

El compromiso de SunLine con opciones de aire limpio y combustibles alternativos se extiende más allá de nuestra propia flota. SunFuels ofrece dos estaciones de combustible alternativas en todo el Valle de Coachella para aumentar su movilidad. Ubicaciones en nuestras instalaciones en Thousand Palms e Indio, nuestra estación de servicio pública de GNC las 24 horas acepta VISA, MasterCard, Wright Express y Voyager para el pago. Nuestros dispensadores de GNC tienen un lector de tarjetas integrado y dispensan tanto 3000 psig como 3600 psig.

SUNDIAL - SERVICIO DE PARATRANSPORTE

El servicio SunDial es un servicio de transporte público de viaje compartido de origen a destino para las personas que no puedan usar el servicio de trayecto fijo de manera permanente o en determinadas condiciones. La elegibilidad no solo se basa en si tiene una discapacidad. El servicio SunDial solo está disponible dentro de los $\frac{3}{4}$ de milla hacia cualquier lado de un trayecto local fijo de SunBus y solo puede usarse en los mismos horarios, días y frecuencia que el servicio local de trayecto fijo. El servicio SunDial no se ofrece en el área de servicio del Enlace de cercanías 10 de SunLine (servicio entre Indio y San Bernardino).

El conductor de SunDial lo esperará en la acera de una calle pública de una calle pública, en frente o lo más cerca posible de su casa, edificio u otro lugar de recogida designado que sea seguro. El servicio puerta a puerta está disponible para los pasajeros discapacitados que requieran más ayuda. Estos deben identificarse como



tales en el momento de la reserva. Esté atento al vehículo, ya que el conductor no esperará más de cinco minutos para que salga y se suba al vehículo. Los conductores de SunDial no pueden ingresar a las entradas de auto privadas. Compartirá el viaje con otros clientes. Durante el viaje, el conductor puede recoger o dejar a otras personas, así que programe su viaje en consecuencia. Si no desea realizar un viaje programado, llame de inmediato a SunDial Reservations y cancele el viaje. Los viajes que no se cancelen al menos dos horas antes de la hora de recogida programada se considerarán cancelaciones tardías.

SUNDIAL - SERVICIO DE PARATRANSPORTE

Si un viaje no se cancela antes de la hora de recogida programada y el pasajero no se presenta, se considerará una ausencia. SunLine se reserva el derecho a suspender el servicio a los clientes.

¿QUIÉN PUEDE USAR SUNDIAL?

Las personas que tengan determinadas discapacidades que les impidan usar el sistema de transporte público de trayecto fijo de SunBus y tengan una tarjeta de identificación de Certificación de la ADA de SunDial. Estas discapacidades pueden ser:

- Visuales


Los pasajeros de SunDial deben completar el proceso de elegibilidad de SunLine y recibir una tarjeta de identificación de Certificación de la ADA de SunDial. Las personas que visiten el Coachella Valley pueden obtener un pase de servicio de 21-días si contratan SunLine con antelación y proporcionan evidencia o la certificación de su discapacidad de otra agencia de transporte público.

PARA SU SEGURIDAD

La ley federal y estatal requiere que todos los clientes de SunDial usen un cinturón de seguridad y un arnés de hombro mientras viajan en los vehículos. El conductor se asegurará de que todos los clientes estén seguros antes de iniciar el viaje y los ayudará a colocarse y quitarse estos dispositivos.
